Official Informational Sheet 2008-2009

Expectations:

- In order to be classified as a multimedia, entries should include all or some of the following features: text, graphics, animation, audio, and video.
- If any material in your entry is not self-created, please list your sources on an attached sheet.
- If any material is copyrighted, please attach authorization for its use. Beware of copyright—complete music clips are considered copyright protected and may not be used in a winning project.
- Entries may be submitted on a USB flash drive, a zip disk, DVD, or a CD.
- Approved Software Packages are as follows: Pixie, Photostory, PowerPoint, Windows Movie Maker, Quicktime, iMovie, KidPix, and Vodcasts.
- **All entries must be viewable/playable on a PC.**

Contest Guidelines:

1. Only 2 entries per school per category.
2. Group entries are permitted but are limited to **5 students per group**.
3. Grade Level categories are: K-2, 3-5, 6-8, 9-12.
4. One free registration to the MICCA Conference will be awarded to the lead teacher sponsor.
5. **The lead teacher sponsor must be a current MICCA member.**
6. All entries must have been completed between January 1, 2008 through January 31, 2009.
7. Only students attending schools in the state of Maryland are eligible to participate in this contest.
7. Prizes will be awarded to one winner/group per category and will be awarded at the 2009 MICCA Conference.
9. A completed and eligible entry form **must** accompany all entries.
